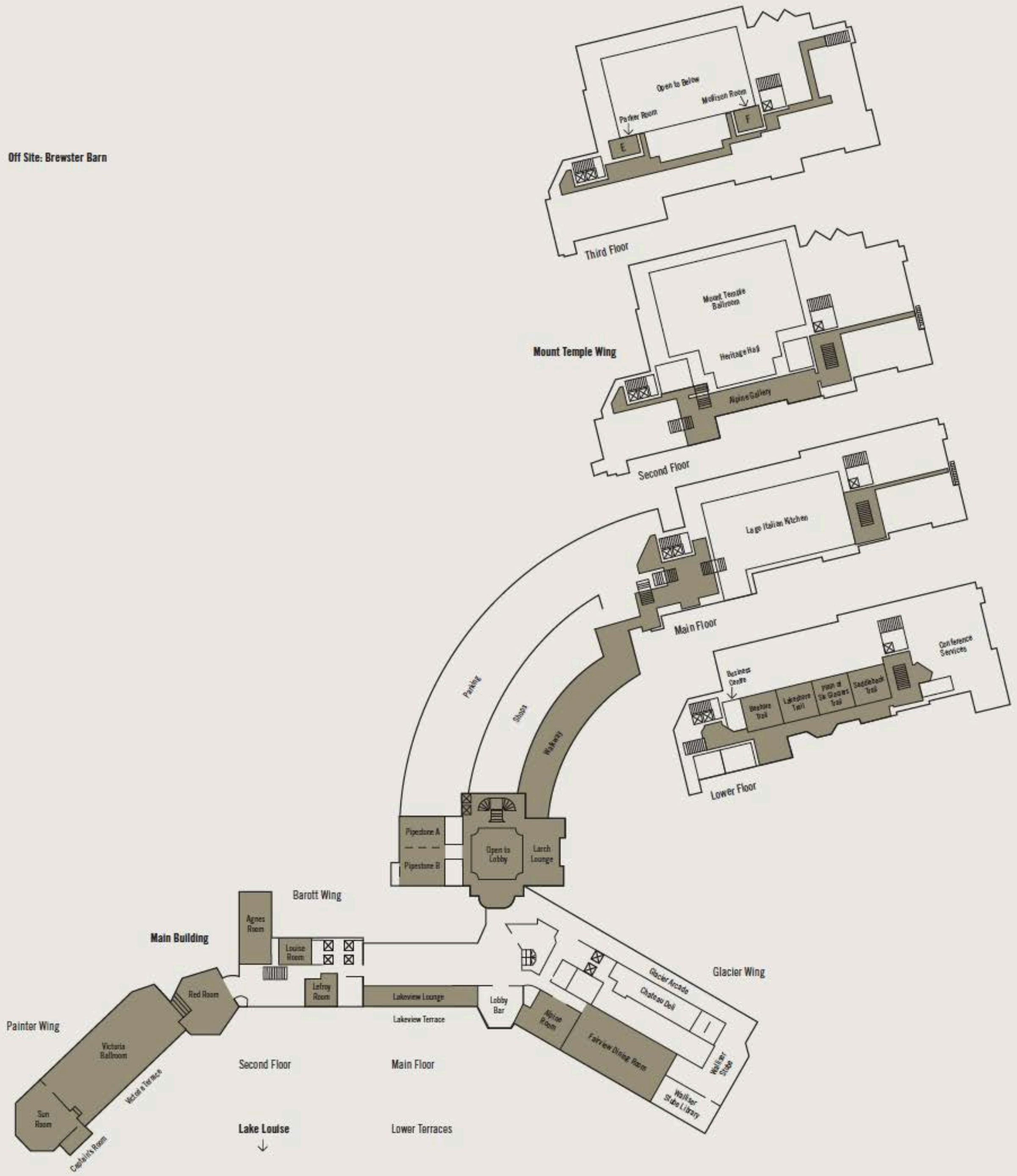

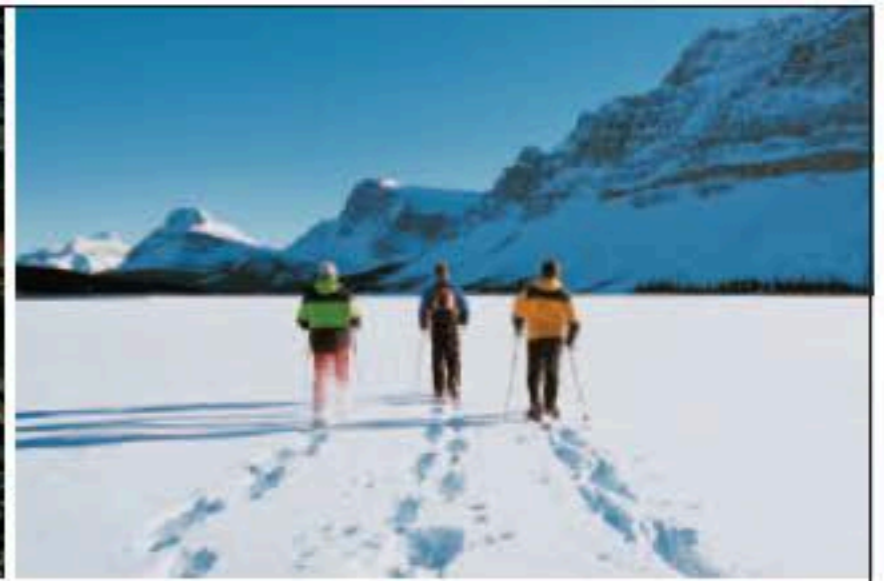
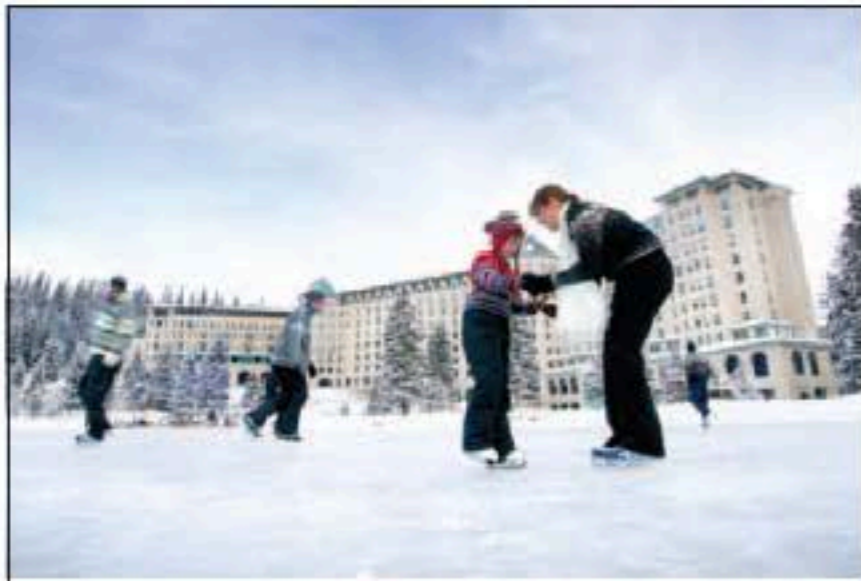

WINTER ACTIVITIES

Downhill skiing and snowboarding

Surrounded by snow-frosted Rocky Mountain peaks, and showcased by a majestic glacier, The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise awaits your arrival. In the heart of some of the world's most extraordinary downhill areas, the ski season typically runs from mid-November to mid-May.

Lake Louise Ski Area, 10 minutes away, is one of Canada's largest ski areas, with a 990-metre (3,250-foot) vertical drop, spread over four mountain faces, over 1,700 skiable hectares (4,200 acres) and 113 named runs. For the past decade, Lake Louise has been the host site for the Men's and Women's World Cup ski races.

Sunshine Village, only 40 minutes away, is a vast bowl of deep snow that averages 9 metres (30 feet) of powder from November to June — the longest ski season in Canada.

Banff's Mount Norquay, located 45 minutes away, above the town of Banff, offers a wide range of terrain and the rare experience of night skiing.

Kicking Horse Resort — with many winter activities, including skiing and tubing — is a short drive into British Columbia.

Cross-country and heli-skiing

Take in the breathtaking views along the cross-country trails, accessible from your doorstep, or book an extreme adventure and the ultimate thrill — heli-skiing.

Getting to The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise

Choose from shuttle transfer, taxi, private-car service or car rental. For assistance with your transportation booking, please contact our concierge.

From Calgary International Airport (about 2 hours):

- When exiting the Calgary Airport, turn left onto Barlow Trail NE
- Turn left onto 96 Ave NE
- Merge onto Deerfoot Trail/Highway #2 North
- Follow Deerfoot Trail/Highway #2 North to exit ramp and onto Stoney Trail West
- Take exit 36 for AB-1 W/Trans-Canada Highway W toward 16 Avenue N/Banff
- 16th Avenue becomes Trans-Canada Highway 1, which takes you straight to Banff (a 45- to 60-minute drive)
- In Banff National Park, follow the signs for the hamlet of Lake Louise, continuing on the Trans-Canada Highway. (note: there is an entrance fee at the park gates)
- 40 minutes past the town of Banff, take the turnoff marked for Lake Louise.
- Turn left at the intersection, proceed through two stop signs and continue on this road for 4 kilometers (2.4 miles).
