### **LB** Distillery

Saskatoon's first micro distillery and one of only a handful across the country. Tasting room and private event space available.

### Black Fox Farm and Distillery

Saskatchewan's premier on-farm distillery committed to conservation, sustainability, self-sufficiency and using the best available practices from all types of farming. Homegrown produce, flowers and grains are used to make their own gin, vodka and other spirits. Pick your own flowers from the spectacular prairie gardens or go pumpkin picking in the Fall. Tours and tastings are available year round.

#### The Glen at Crossmount

A beautiful backdrop to taste handcrafted cider made from 100% Canadian apples. An arts barn, meeting space and catering also available.

#### 9 Mile Legacy Brewing

This growing brewery has fun producing authentic, traditionally-styled beer while pushing the boundaries of what beer can be. Tastings and merchandise available as well as private event space.

#### HISTORY AND CULTURE

### **Wanuskewin Heritage Park**

A National Heritage site which celebrates Métis and Plains First Nations cultures. Today guests are immersed in over 6000 years of history through programs, exhibits, cuisine and art. Guided walks, tipi raising, dream catcher crafting and First Nations traditional dancing demonstrations are just a few of the experiences offered.

#### Marr Marr

A simple two-storey frame house built in the 1884 is the oldest building in the city. Still standing in its original location and open to the public.

#### Museum of Antiquities

See the amazing artistic and cultural accomplishments of civilizations from the age of antiquity. Replica and

original pieces from ancient Egypt and the Near East to Greece, Rome and the Middle Ages.
